She currently serves as the Director of Outreach for International Justice Central (IJCentral), an outreach initiative launched in conjunction with the documentary film *The Reckoning*.

Ms. Dunphy is completing her Masters in Conflict and Security at the Graduate Program in International Affairs at the New School. She holds a BA in International Criminal Justice and Post-Conflict Resolution from New York University.
