Fully aware that these same differences may lead to disputes that unfortunately turn into violent conflict fueled by the passions of despotic leaders at the expense of resources and people--even those far removed from the center of the disputes, and

Affirming the preamble of the Rome Statute as well as the mission, vision and goals of the International Criminal Court (ICC), and

Being convinced that peace is possible only when justice uncovers the impunity of those who commit, condone or turn away from the most heinous acts that ignore the Human Rights of all, and

Concerned that without the collective work of organizations to educate and encourage the full cooperation of the United States with the Rome Statute and the International Criminal Court, the United States and our global neighbors will never realize true collaboration while bringing to justice those who would ignore our Human Rights, and

Noting with satisfaction that the role of the American Non-governmental Organizations Coalition for the International Criminal Court (AMICC) is essential to realizing full United States ratification of the Rome Statute and participation in the ICC:

Has agreed to

1. Support without reservation the the spirit of the Rome Statute and the work of the of the ICC as we follow the guidance and example of AMICC, and
2. Call upon all our members, volunteers and friends to join us in our goal to seek peace and justice as we educate and enlighten others of this great work-- all this, in accordance with our mission and Human Right #30 that calls everyone to be responsible by informing others of their rights.
