DAVID KAY, FORMER CHIEF U.S. WEAPONS INSPECTOR IN IRAQ: Well, the president called -- and I think very wisely -- for international criminalization through the U.N. of states and individuals who engage in the proliferation and exchange of nuclear materials. The problem with that is this administration certainly has not been an advocate of the International Criminal Court or international criminal jurisdiction. And just this past week, we applauded the Pakistani decision to pardon A.Q. Khan, who is the poster boy, for running a Sam's Club for nuclear technology. Our policy has been inconsistent on this, and, believe me, other states will point that out.
