

A Petition to Protect American Servicemen and Civilians from the U.N. Criminal Court Presented to President George W. Bush

Whereas, days before he left office, Bill Clinton signed the treaty creating the International Criminal Court; and,

Whereas, this U.N. Court is now in existence and claims authority over American soldiers and civilians; and,

Whereas, the U.N. Court does not guarantee American citizens the rights of the U.S. Constitution including the right to appeal, protection against double jeopardy, and the right to confront your accuser; therefore,

Whereas, any action taken by or on behalf of the International Criminal Court against any member of the U.S. Armed Forces should be considered an act of aggression against the United States.

Be it resolved, that President George W. Bush should immediately support - the "American Servicemember and Citizen Protection Act of 2002" - to stop all cooperation with this illegal U.N. Court.
