

**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR AN INTERNATIONAL
CRIMINAL COURT**

Whereas the establishment of an International Criminal Court (ICC) is important for the promotion of international justice and peace, to deter the commission of future war crimes or crimes against humanity, and

Whereas the current U.S. Government policy opposes the establishment of the ICC, and

Whereas we believe that peace and justice groups in the U.S. should actively work together for the U.S. to join with other countries ratifying the ICC,

Therefore, it is hereby resolved that the Fellowship of Reconciliation USA join the international coalition in support of establishment of the International Criminal Court and join other U.S. groups in forming a U.S. coalition in support of the International Criminal Court.
